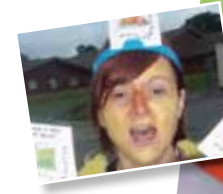

## Who or What is 'Over the Wall'?

We are a charity and part of the Association of Hole in the Wall Camps which was established after actor Paul Newman founded the first camp in the United States in 1988.

We have been running residential activity camps in the UK for over ten years.

Our camps are for children and young people aged between 8 and 17 who have been attending hospital and we also run separate camps for brothers and sisters.

## What can I do at camp?

There are Activity Leaders at each activity who will explain what you will be doing and your Team Mates will also be there to help you if you need them. Every day is filled with creative and fun activities such as:

- Swimming
- Arts and Crafts
- Climbing & Abseiling
- Sports
- Music and Drama
- Horse Riding
- Archery and
- Evening entertainment: great events like a Disco and a Talent Night!



## Where does it all happen?

We have camps in 3 locations:

- Tulliallan Castle in Scotland,
- Pioneer Centre, near Kidderminster in the Midlands and
- Bryanston School in Dorset.

## Where do I sleep?

Our camps have different bedroom arrangements but you will always have a comfortable room either on your own or sharing with someone your own age.



## Who else will be there?

Each of our camps caters for up to 60 campers and you will be in a group of 8+ other campers your own age and gender. There will be a team of volunteers with your group to make sure you have everything you need for a fun and memorable week at camp.

## What's the food like?

The food is plentiful and very good and there is always a choice at breakfast, lunch and dinner. The good thing is that you don't have to cook it or clean up your dishes afterwards!!

## What medical care is provided at Over the Wall?

We have a team of nurses and doctors who also attend camp and they will look after your medical & health needs.
