Key Responsibilities:

- Managed by the Senior Regional Development Manager, and in collaboration with Heritage Officer, promote OTWC and raise awareness by organising and facilitating visits to the Ockbrook site, engaging the local community, and garnering support and membership for the Friends of Over The Wall Camp Group.
- Capitalise on engagement opportunities to promote support for OTWC.
- Work with the Heritage Officer to prepare and deliver presentations to various groups to promote the site's heritage and OTWC activities.
- Manage the administration of the 'Friends of Over The Wall Camp Group'.
- Collaborate proactively with the Embark Federation and other schools to promote the use of the site for educational, play, and heritage purposes.
- Volunteer management, establishing and managing different site community groups, such as events committee, to enhance local engagement and support for onsite and offsite activities.

- Ensure broad and diverse community engagement, especially in reaching diverse, disadvantaged, and vulnerable populations.
- Manage meeting preparations and ensure the site is prepared for visits/presentations, working closely with the leadership team and other staff.
- Perform any other tasks as required to support the mission of OTWC.
